The Postal Museum is situated in the heart of London. It contains 500 years of communications from the reign of Henry VIII to the first postal stamp, the introduction of a postal code and up to the present internet age.

A tour of the Museum and a ride on the Mail Rail has been organised.

I hope we shall arrive at the Museum by 10.30am in time for a coffee and comfort break. Our morning will be spent with the tour, train ride and a leisurely look around the Museum.

The Museum Café sells snacks for lunch, but there are pubs in the immediate vicinity.

In the afternoon there will be time to explore the area surrounding the Museum. The Charles Dickens Museum in Doughty Street, a 20 minute walk away (Entrance fee £7.50), which has a café, or The Foundling Museum in Brunswick Square a 10-minute walk (£9.90 entrance fee)
